Wednesday 12 May 2021	<p><b>Dealing with the learning Gap created by the Covid crisis – Another Option Course Number:GP02</b></p> <p>I believe that we are unwittingly accelerating in the wrong direction because of COVID. The fears and pressures caused by COVID will only exacerbate the practice of mollycoddling a generation of children, which will result in more unmotivated children without grit, who have poor social skills and who lack perseverance when faced with a challenging task. Too often otherwise healthy and capable children are labelled with a variety of disorders, placed in remedial classes, and/or prescribed medication. Remedial classes in schools are getting larger while the number of high achieving university graduates is getting smaller. So, despite our best intentions we seem to be creating generations of children who are self-centred and overly sensitive, have no grit, lack joy, unmotivated, entitled, and unable to establish effective and empathic relationships. There is another more effective, less stressful and inexpensive option.
